The Mercantile Athletes have trained well under the guidance of Al Matthews, Head Coach, Annabelle Eaton (Women's Coach), David Colvin (U21 men) and Sam Fennessy (U21 women). Al Mathews was selected to coach the U23 Women's Coxless Four, achieving a Bronze Medal in the U23 World Championships. Annabelle Eaton was selected to coach the U23 Women's Coxed Four, training out of Princeton, USA. After a short training period the U23 Women's Coxed Four won Gold at the U23 World Championships.

I would like to take the time to thank Sam Fenessey for his work at Mercantile over many years, coaching the U21 Women. Sam has moved to Sydney to coach at Haberfield Rowing Club, we wish him well in his new role in NSW.

We welcomed Zoe Fettig-Winn, from Canada, who will coach the U21 women. Zoe brings with her significant experience as the Assistant Women's Coach at the University of British

Columbia. After a quick hand over, Zoe coaching is in full swing with the U21 women.

#### Winter Program

This winter, with the support of the committee, Al Matthews initiated the Winter Training Program for Year 10-12 students, to train with Mercantile for 12 weeks. During this time, athletes were provided with a training program and 3 sessions on the water each week. The program was very successful many young men and women as part of the program.

Watching these eight athletes' journeys, while they seem far away from us at times, reminds us of the strength of character and work ethic required to be the best of the best in Rowing and that they too started out here. The success in the men's and women's eights at the World Cup regattas and World Championships this year in particular has been exciting to see, and we look forward to what next year brings.

Our domestic athlete group have put together another solid season of work and development under the guidance of our coaching team. On behalf of The Club we commend you for your commitment to excellence. Season highlights from the High Performance (HP) squad include the selection of 23 Mercs athletes and coaches on the Victorian team this year. Austin Reinehr's selection into the U23 Australian Rowing Team and silver medal performance in the Men's Four. Louisa Bongrain, Sophie Reinehr and Ben Whitmee's representation at the FISU World University Games most recently.

The Australian Rowing Championships took place at Champion Lakes, Western Australia this year. I would like to acknowledge the generous donation of the New Trailer 'Trailer Al' without which our boats may not have made it there. Thank you also to past President Mal Batten and past Captain Billy Webster for their assistance in transport

of the boats and as always to Jenny Fraumano for her coordination of the Nationals efforts. The Club came away with 17 medal performances and a lot of good racing experience to springboard into the next season.

Behind every success there is a team of people involved and so thank you first to our amazing HP volunteer coaches who give of their time so generously; Tim Frederico, Pete Somerville, Jess Hare and Jason Izydorczyk. To quote Tim Freddy (our Kieth Bilney coaches award recipient for 2023) 'it is extra special to be rewarded for something you love doing'. For this we are grateful.

To our employed coaching staff; Alistair Matthews (Bronze U23 World Champs Medallist 2023), Annabelle Eaton (Gold U23 World Champs Medallist 2023), David (Chipper) Colvin and Sam Fenessy. Your leadership and enthusiasm are appreciated more than you know. In particular, to Sam Fennessy, your contribution to U21 Women's Rowing and the friendships and mentorships you have made are lasting and impactful. We wish you all the best for your coaching in Sydney. To Zoe Fettig-Winn, we warmly welcome you to our HP Coaching Team. You have already made good headway with the women in a few short months. We look forward to what the whole team can produce in the season ahead.

A major fundraising effort this year was for the purchase of a Women's Empacher eight which has arrived in the sheds just this month and will be used by our top women for its first race this coming Melbourne Head and Head of the Yarra. Race well! Congratulations to all involved in the fundraising efforts.

Club Rowing is one of the club's five strategic objectives and so is a critical part of The Club's culture and existence. Proudly, this program has achieved the recruiting aims of 40 grade athletes across the men's and women's programs thanks to the voluntary efforts of Andrew McNeil and Jordan King. The Club athletes contributed a huge portion of the points towards Mercantile winning the Victorian Premiership including some outstanding individual efforts by Samuel Wilson, Jordan King, Alexandra Legge, Cate McNeil and Jenisi Kelderman who all received awards at the Rowing Victoria AGM this year. We also acknowledge the strategy and effort behind the coaching team to bring this operation to life. Well done. Club Rowing looks to lift its medal count yet again this year and we welcome Nick Reish the new Club Women's Lead to help. You have already made impact with a businesslike mindset to training and racing, we

like the structure and direction you have brought to this squad.

To the Mercantile committee, thank you for your volunteer time and energy. Thank you especially to Gina for your leadership; 'Help will always be given at Hogwarts (Mercantile) to those who ask for it'. I have always found this true and that with your leadership the club is in good hands, thank you.

## 2023 Treasurer's Report

#### **Duncan MacKinnon**

To be frank, when I wrote this report a year ago, I was worried. The club had suffered a material loss and although Mercantile is imbued with a sense of optimism, and a "can do" attitude, I was concerned that our fragile finances would create some issues, and jeopardise our long-term goals.

This year however we're in a much better position, although much of the surplus you will see reported is due to improved Endowment Fund our investments, which continue to be added to by the generosity of members such as Sean Colgan and Andrew Guerin. Nevertheless the club's standalone underlying cash position has increased by about \$50k, compared with a reduction of about \$42k last year. Part of this increase is due to additional support from Rowing Victoria, who recognised the burden imposed on the club by having two of our coaches, Al & Annabelle, appointed to National Team duties. We appreciate Rowing Victoria's contribution.

School holiday camps were also a welcome additional source of income for us, netting about \$25k, which assisted with our coaching salaries, which are our largest expense. Special mention must go to **Meg Hester**, who has driven this initiative. We also received income from insurance claims, but the downside has been that our premia for the 2023-24 insurance year have increased by about 10%.

With the Nationals in Perth this year, it was difficult to balance a conservative budgeted cost against a reasonable

charge to our travelling athletes. We made a small \$3k loss on the exercise, but from my perspective the most important thing was that all our members and their boats & oars travelled across and back safely - but again some of this was due to the repeated generosity of **Sean Colgan**, who donated the cost of the new trailer to the club.

We didn't spend much on boats this year, buying two single sculls only, but that created some headroom to use the Frederico Fund's annual grant towards boats & equipment to make the club's annual repayment to the Endowment Fund, so we'll be in a reasonable position to renovate the boathouse again before the lease expires in a little over 10 years.

There has also been an unwelcome increase in the debts owed by athletes to the club. Last year we reported about \$2k in outstanding debts, but this year it has increased to \$6k. These are real costs which the club has outlaid on behalf of athletes, and it is important that they be repaid promptly, from the club's cash flow perspective, and to reduce the administrative workload of marking athletes as being ineligible to race within Rowing Manager.

As always I am personally grateful for the support of pragmatic, wiser people on the Committee, and particularly appreciative of those individuals (many of whom are listed inside the front cover of this report) who consistently donate to support the long-term success of the club. We appreciate their contributions.

## Foundation Report

On behalf of the trustees, John Harry, Malcolm Batten, Jeff Lawrence, Tim Frederico and Andrew Guerin, the following progress report is provided.

The fifth strategic objective of the Club is to secure the financial future of the Club. This is achieved through the operation of the Foundation.

#### Thank You

A great thank you to all our donors and specifically to our cornerstone donors **Sean and Bibi Colgan** through their Colgan Foundation, to Jim Sprigg for the founding donation and Andrew Guerin for is ongoing generosity and also leadership.

#### Strategic Plan

The long-term aspiration of the Foundation is to allow Mercantile Rowing Club to be financially viable, forever. The specific objectives are:

- Provision of a suitable boathouse.
- Provision of equipment necessary to support our rower's aspirations.
- Supporting members who pay national team seat fees.
- Supporting our coaching team to ensure full coverage of our needs.
- Supporting our volunteers.

#### 2023 Distributions

This year the Foundation made a \$50,000 contribution towards the Club's equipment needs and substantial contributions towards members' seat fees in Australian crews, including those racing at the World University Games. The Foundation aims to provide the Club about 4% of the capital annually.

#### Governance

The trustees review and supervise the portfolio throughout the year. The

trustees are pleased with the investment strategy and the work of the investment managers LGT Crestone.

#### Structure

The Foundation has outgrown the current structure and the Trustees are working on implementing a new perpetual structure in the coming year. The structure will be placed before members for approval in due course.

#### 1880 Circle

It is clear that for the Foundation to achieve its aims, capital of about \$10mil in todays dollars will be required. The only way to achieve this is through some substantial bequests. The 1880 Circle has been created to recognise these generous members, and they will be publicly recognised.

We encourage members to consider the Club in their Estate planning. Please do not hesitate to discuss your situation with any one of the Trustees

To this end we wish to recognize members who have recorded Mercantile as a beneficiary of their estate. We are aware of many Club members who have already undertaken this and in due course we will seek to publicly recognise them.

#### F R Browne Memorial Trophy

For the 2022/23 season, the F R Browne Memorial Trophy is awarded to **Austin Reinehr** for cracking into the Australian lightweight men's double scull.

#### H R Frederico Memorial Trophy

This trophy, made available by the Late Honourable Justice H R Frederico, is awarded annually to the most improved oarswoman at the Club.

For the 2022/23 season, the H R Frederico Memorial Trophy is awarded to **Paige Barr**.

#### **Keith Bilney Coaches Trophy**

This trophy was established in the memory of Keith Bilney who gave nearly 70 years of service to rowing as a coxswain, sculler, oarsman, administrator but, most of all coach. He gave of his time freely, instilling in his charges a love of the sport, and a burning desire to win, but with a balanced approach to life. The trophy is awarded to the coach that is not necessarily the most successful in terms of race wins, but the one who does the most to teach oarsmen and oarswomen

how to row, win races and achieve their potential, and in so doing develop the foundations of the Club and build and maintain the attitudes of sportsmanship, dedication and loyalty.

For the 2022/23 season, the Keith Bilney Coach's Trophy is awarded to **Tim Frederico.** Tim, you have been the voice of reason and inspiration to your athletes. We hear nothing but praise and gratefulness from your Club men's group and for that we thank you. Season highlights will have to be the silver medal in the club mens four at the National Championships, congratulations.

#### Jay Loveless Trophy

This trophy was established as a result of a bequest from the estate of the Late Jay Loveless. Jay was the mother of Ricky Loveless, who coxed for the Club Ricky was tragically killed in a road accident while riding to Mercantile and Jay remained a supporter of the Club until her passing in late 2006. It was Jay's wish that a trophy be established for the Most Outstanding Oarswoman each season.

For the 2022/23 season, the Jay Loveless Trophy is awarded to **Jess Morrison** .

#### **Martin Owen Trophy**

With the establishment of the Loveless Trophy, the Committee deemed it appropriate to establish a trophy for the Most Outstanding Oarsman each season. For the 2022/23 season, the Most Outstanding Oarsman Trophy is awarded jointly to Jack Robertson and Angus Widdicomber

The highlights have got to be your win in the World Cup III, silver medal in World Cup II and bronze in the World Rowing Championships. The club was incredibly proud to see your success and we cannot wait to follow your crew's journey into the Paris Olympics

## The Icarus - AKA The Jim Sprigg award for endeavour in rowing.

This trophy (a statue of Icarus), has been made available this year for the first time by the club's current Performance Director Sam Patten. It is named after Icarus, the son of a Greek legend craftsman. The craftsman created wings made of feathers and wax for them to escape from their Island Prison. Despite instructions from his father not to fly too high, Icarus does so, the wax melts and he falls from the sky and drowns from his effort. This award is won by someone who demonstrates their endeavour or 'will to win' despite the odds and despite the actual outcome of their effort.

For the 2022/23 season, the Icarus Trophy is award to Angus Widdicombe.

Sam Patten noted a discussion with you following the Tokyo Olympics and has watched on at your superb leadership within the Mens eight crew. He can see the 'will to win' and the strive for excellence to which you have been awarded this trophy for.


