

1925 Australian Ladies' Rowing Council meeting

The 1925 conference was conducted on April 17, 1925 at Albert Park Ladies Rowing Club, Melbourne.

Discussion took place re type of boat to be used at Interstate races. Mm. Orme moved that the state in which the race is being rowed to supply the type of boats procurable either practice or racing clinkers. M. Abercrombie seconded. Carried unanimously.

Miss Abercrombie moved Mrs. Bentley seconded the confirmation of affiliation of the original Clubs with the Council.

Mrs. Pitman moved and seconded by Miss Nelson (proxy for QLD.) the affiliation of the Victorian Ladies Rowing Association with the Council. Carried unanimously.

Mrs. Bentley moved that closing date for interstate race be a fortnight before race. Carried.
