

# 1935 Australian Ladies' Rowing Council meeting

Conference held Port Adelaide Town Hall April 1935.

Mrs. Gideon moved that a floating insurance policy be taken out covering anywhere in Australia, the Australian Championship Trophy, "Bertha" by the Australian Council. Miss Pridham seconded.

Miss Johnston moved an amendment that the council take out an insurance policy covering the trophy "Bertha" such council to be reimbursed per annum for the amount of premium paid by the State Association holding the said trophy. Miss Bradley seconded the amendment - carried.

Moved Mrs. Gideon that the Australian Rowing Council supply winning crew with pennant for Championship Race. If unable to supply same, each Assoc. to be levied to raise amount of money required. This motion seconded by Miss Pridham. Lost.

Mrs. Gideon then asked a question regard to rowers transferring from one state to another without first securing a clearance. This was disallowed as the matter had not appeared on the agenda and there was no General Business under which this matter could be discussed, all states having been advised that no business other than that appearing on the agenda would be dealt with.

Mrs. Gideon then pointed out that the constitution mentioned that a chairwoman shall be appointed to preside at the conference. As this was at the termination of the meeting and no objection had been raised at the commencement this matter lapsed.
