### RECORD OF INTER-SCHOOL RACES FOR FIRST CREWS THE BLACKMORE SHIELD

Presented by the late E. G. Blackmore, Esq., in 1893 for competition between Prince Alfred College and St. Peter's College. Rowed in fours on the Port River from 1893-6, and won each time by S.P.S.C. The race then lapsed until 1931, when it was transferred to the Torrens and rowed in eights. Between 1931 and 1958, when a special race was discontinued, the shield was won 16 times by S.P.S.C. and 11 times by P.A.C.

#### SECOND VIII'S

The Clinker IV event was constituted the Second Crews' Race in 1938, and was rowed in eights from 1957.

#### OPEN, UNDER 16 and UNDER 15 IV'S

These events were rowed on fixed seats until the introduction of slides for Open and Under 16 Fours in 1937, and Under 15 Fours in 1938. In 1932 and 1933 Open Tub Slides were rowed as well as Open Fixed and were won both years by S.P.S.C.

#### OLD SCHOLARS' VIII'S

This race was not rowed during War years 1942 to 1945, or in 1960 due to the Regatta being held in conjunction with that of the A.U.B.C.

#### GENERAL

Poliomyelitis Epidemics cancelled the 1948 and 1950 Regattas P.G.S., K.C., and C.B.C. entered the Regatta in 1961, S.H.C. in 1963. S.H.C. withdrew in 1967.

In 1967 the regatta was conducted at Port Adelaide.
