




# In 2009 Christian Brothers College in its 131st Year is celebrating 100 Years since the introduction of competitive rowing in the purple and white!

Initially CBC boats were borrowed from the Mercantile Rowing Club but by 1911 the first boat had been purchased. The best crew was chosen, training was under the guidance of one of Australia's best oarsmen, old boy Mr. W. Kennedy and the school entered the inter-collegiate event. CBC enjoyed its first victory in what was then known as the School's Championship on the Torrens in 1912.





# The HEAD OF THE RIVER Regatta

In 1922 the public schools regatta "Head of the River" had its inception on the Torrens Lake as a result of a challenge between Saint Peters College and Adelaide High School. These two schools were later joined by Scotch College in 1927 and Prince Alfred College in 1931 and later by other schools.

#### General

Poliomyelitis Epidemics cancelled the 1948 and 1950 Regattas. PGS, KC and CBC entered the Regatta in 1961, SHC in 1963 and then withdrew in 1967. In 1967 the Regatta was conducted at Port Adelaide. In 1974 Kings College was changed to Pembroke School. In 1977 the Regattas was moved to West Lakes. Unley High School entered in 1978, Wilderness School in 1987, Walford in 1989, Siena in 1999 and Norwood-Morialta High School in 2001. Siena withdrew in 2002. Seymour College entered in 2006 and Annesley College in 2007.

#### Second VIII's

The Clinker IV event was constituted the Second Crew's Race in 1938, and was rowed in eights from 1957.

#### Open, Under 16 and Under 15 IV's

These events were rowed on fixed seats until the introduction of slides for Open and Under 16 Fours in 1937, and Under 15 Fours in 1938. In 1932 and 1933 Open tub Slides were rowed as well as Open Fixed and were won both years by SPSC.

#### Under 14 Quad Sculls

Quad sculls replaced sweep oar fours in division A in 1991, division B in 1992 & division C in 1993. The under 14 age division was replaced by Year 9 in 2000.

#### Under 15 Quad Sculls

Quad sculls replaced sweep oar fours in division C and D in 1999 & division A and B in 2000. The under 15 age division was replaced by Year 10 in 2000.




## WEST LAKES - Celebrating 30 years

#### SARA West Lakes Aquatic Centre

With great vision, the SA Rowing Association and Foundation Life Members as well as other supporters (Union of Old Oarsmen & Resting Rowers Consortium) purchased land in 1972 at 100 Military Rd to start the West Lakes Aquatic Centre.

The first stage of the centre was constructed in 1978 and consisted of a social facility, kiosk, male and female change rooms, and a boat storage area. Various stages of building have taken place with Stage 5 of the building completed in 2003 at a cost of nearly \$1million. Funding for the construction of the centre to date has been provided by the SA Rowing Association, the occupying clubs/schools, Foundation Life Members, sponsors, success State Government grants, and the City of Charles Sturt.

The minor works carried out in 2006/2007 (landscaping, irrigation, maintenance) cost a further \$200,000, with the northern washdown area still to be completed.



#### A M. Ramsay Regatta Course

The late 1970's saw the design and construction of a course buoying system that, along pontoons for a held start, and a stretch of water eight lanes wide, 2400m long and at least 3.5m deep enabled the course to gain FISA accreditation. This qualified the course and on shore facilities to be considered for national and international events such as the World Masters Rowing Championships held on the course in 1997.

The course subsequently lost its accreditation due to increasing Occupation, Health and Safety standards, the increasing sophistication of FISA requirements and because equipment has outlived its life expectancy.

Since 1999, when the National Championships were last held at West Lakes, SARA has been working with the State Government to complete an upgrade of the regatta course facilities. A Feasibility Study was completed in 2005 and \$2.4million was allocated for the course upgrade in June 2007 by Minister Michael Wright. The construction has now commenced and is due for completion in May 2009. The construction will comprise;

On water — provide fixed start pontoons and easily erected / moved buoy lines for the sports of Rowing, Canoeing and Dragon Boats

Off water— provide finish pontoons

Tenders have been called for the upgrade of the finishing tower which is closing at end of March 2009 with construction expected to commence shortly after.

Further plans are being made for the safe access for all users including people with disability via ramps and lift access which will involve a major renovation of the clubrooms.

# **TRAFFIC RULES & COXSWAINS**

Always boat with your bow-ball to the south and use the IN / OUT areas of the beach as shown on the map.


#### 1. TRAINING

During training (up to ½ hour before the first race) crews travel to the Start in Lane 0 and then down the course in Lanes 3 – 6.

- □ Please keep Lane 1 and 2 free.
- Please do not congest the Start or Finish line area.

#### 2. RACING

Warm up is Lane 0 to the Start for 2,000m 1,500m or 1,000m. With 5minute intervals between races it may be possible, but unlikely, to do practice starts in your allocated lane.



#### 3. Coxswains Weights

All crews (except Year 9) = 50kg minimum weight; Year 9 = 40 kg minimum weight; All weights must be appropriate (metal / lead) in a separate, sealed bag.

#### PERPETUAL TROPHIES

At the conclusion of the Regatta, shields and trophies and medals will be presented to the winning crews by the Adelaide High School, 1958 Gosse Shield winning crew.

#### The Florence Eaton Cup - Girls' First VIIIs

Presented to honour Florence Eaton who began an illustrious rowing career when she represented South Australia in 1922. Later she served as President of the Australian Women's Rowing Council and remained a strong supporter of schoolgirl rowing. This year a replacement trophy has been kindly donated by a group of Walford Masters rowers.

#### The Adelaide High Centenary Trophy - Girls' Second VIIIs

First presented in 2008 by Adelaide High School to commemorate the Centenary of Adelaide High School.

#### The Diana Medlin Cup - Girls' First IVs

Presented in 1991 to honour Diana Medlin the then Head of Pembroke School.

#### The Chilly Parker Cup - Girls' Lightweight IVs

This cup was presented to honour Frau Parker (West German rowing team from 1967-76) who was Rowing Mistress at Walford in 1991. She was a great enthusiast who encouraged schoolgirl rowing in SA.

#### The Amanda Cross Cup - Girls Under 16 IV's / Girls Year 9A Quad Sculls

Presented to honour Amanda Cross, a great SA lightweight rower who represented Australia several times including winning a Bronze Medal at the 1985 World Championships & a Silver Medal at the 1990 World Championships.

#### The Denise Collins Cup - Girls Year 10A IV's

In honour of a great SA Lightweight Rower during the 1980s

#### The Alison Smith Cup - Girls Year 10B IV's

In honour of a great SA rower during the 1980s (Bronze medal W2- at 1986 Commonwealth Games)

#### The Gosse Shield - Boys First VIII's

Presented by the late Sir James Gosse and his family in 1932 as a perpetual trophy to be rowed annually in the "Head of the River" race.

#### The Wallman Trophy - Boys Second VIII's

Presented by the late R.H. Wallman Esq. In 1937 as a perpetual trophy.

#### The Chapman Trophy - Boys Under 16 IV's / Boys' Year 10B Quad Sculls

Presented by the family of the late D.L.Chapman in 1969 in recognition of his contribution to rowing and in particular to the "Head of the River".

#### The Cudmore Cup - Boys Open IV's (1988 Boys First IV's)

Presented by Sir Collier Cudmore in 1966 as a perpetual trophy.

#### The O.C. Menzel Trophy - Boys Lightweight IV's

Presented by O.C. Menzel in 1971 as a perpetual trophy.

#### The Menz Cup - Boys Year 10 IV's

Presented by the Menz Family as a perpetual trophy.

#### The Ferguson Cup - Boys Year 9 IV's

Presented by N.C. Howard in 1972 as a perpetual trophy.

#### QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

As the number of rowing lanes is limited to 7 it was necessary to conduct qualifying heats and repechages prior to the Head of the River Regatta and these were rowed on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> March. Each event could have a maximum of 10 girls' schools and 9 boys' schools competing.

Where events did not require heats / repechages the results of the Head of the River Qualifying races have determined the lane draw with fastest qualifiers placed in centre lanes. The regatta program reflects this draw and would only be changed on the day if the Referee determined that the weather conditions were unfair – in this case the fastest qualifiers would be placed in the most favoured lanes.

2-7 crews All crews proceed directly to the Final

8 - 9 crews Two Heats - first to A Final, rest to repechage

One repechage, first three places to A Final, rest to B Final

10-13 crews Two Heats – first to A Final, rest to one or two repechages

One or Two repechages - first two to A Final, rest to B Final


