

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

INTERPRETATION

The Series will be conducted generally under F.I.S.A. Rules of Racing adapted to cover the special arrangements that have been agreed between the New Zealand Amateur Rowing Association and the Australian Rowing Council Inc regarding the Series.

SENIOR B

A rower shall be classified as Senior B until the 31st December of the year in which he/she reaches the age of 22.

AUSTRALIA- NEW ZEALAND SERIES

Four points for a win and two points for second are allocated in the following priority events - men; single sculls, eights, lightweight fours, lightweight single sculls: women; fours, single sculls, lightweight single sculls. All other events (where national teams from New Zealand and Australia take part) carry two points for a win and one point for second. The first crew only from each country scores points.

REPORTING IN

A member of a crew or their representative must report any scratchings or alterations to the Official Recorder at least 30 minutes prior to the published starting time of their race.

WEIGHING IN

All coxswains shall be weighed not more than two hours and not less than one hour before their first race in any regatta. The Jury may require them to be weighed on more than one occasion.

Lightweight oarsmen and oarswomen shall be weighed in bathing trunks or swimsuits on tested scales not less than one hour and not more than two hours before their first race on each day of racing.

PUNCTUAL STARTING

Boats going to the start must keep clear of races in progress and crews must be at their starting place at least two minutes before the time laid down for the start.

The starter may warn a crew arriving late at its starting position and such warning shall have the same effect as one given for a false start. He may also exclude the crew from the event.

NOTE .

COACHES/ SUPPORTERS WILL BE ALLOWED TO FOLLOW RACES ON BICYCLES PROVIDED EXTREME CARE IS TAKEN THAT RESIDENTS (ESPECIALLY CHILDREN) USING THE TOWPATH ARE NOT ENDANGERED. SHOULD COMPLAINTS FROM RESIDENTS BE RECEIVED PERMISSION TO USE THE BICYCLES WILL BE WITHDRAWN IMMEDIATELY.
